### **1 Samuel 16:5**

I come to make a sacrifice to the Lord.

### **1 Samuel 16:6-13**

When Jesse and his sons arrived, Samuel saw Eliab (THE OLDEST) and thought, “Surely this is the man who the Lord has chosen.” But the Lord said to Samuel, “Do not consider his appearance or his height, for I have rejected him. The Lord does not look at the things people look at. People look at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart.”
